**Motion 1: Closing the 2020 Session** 

Motion Text: Whereas the Cook County Board of Review has finished its adjudication of all valuation appeals timely submitted to it in the course of its review of the 2020 tax year assessment rolls, has transmitted its results to the Office of the Cook County Assessor, which were certified on June 14, 2021, and having completed all other matters as required by the Illinois Property Tax Code, it is therefore moved that the Board of Review close the session for the review of valuation appeals for the 2020 tax year.

**Motion 2: Amendment to Cook County Board of Review Ethics Policy** 

Motion Text: The current CCBOR Ethics Policy should be amended to match the current Cook County Ethics Ordinance so that "family" and "familial relationship" shall be defined as follows: Familial relationship shall mean a person who is related to an official, employee, board or commissioner appointee as spouse or any of the following, whether by blood, marriage or adoption: as parent, father, mother, son, daughter, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, great aunt, great uncle, first cousin, nephew, niece, husband, wife, grandfather, grandmother, grandson, granddaughter, father-in-law, mother-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, stepfather, stepmother, stepson, stepdaughter, stepbrother, stepsister, half-brother, half-sister, and including the father, mother, grandfather, or grandmother of the official's, employee's, board or commission appointee's spouse, domestic partner, civil union partner, parent, child, brother, sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, grandparent, grandchild, father-in-law, mother-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, stepfather, stepmother, stepson, stepdaughter, stepbrother, stepsister, half-brother or half-sister.
