

Cook County Board of Review Remote Attendance Policy

A Commissioner may remotely participate in any meeting of the Board by video or audio conference provided that a quorum of the Board is physically present at the Board meeting, a majority of the Board allows the Commissioner to attend by video or audio conference, and the Commissioner is prevented from physically attending the meeting because of:

- a. personal illness or disability;
- b. employment purposes or the business of the Board;
- c. family or other emergency; or
- d. unexpected childcare obligations.

If a Commissioner wishes to attend a meeting remotely, he or she shall notify the Secretary of the Board or Chief Clerk at least 24 hours before the meeting unless advance notice is impractical. 5 ILCS 120/7 et seq.
